## **Old Business**

### **Review and approve minutes from April:**

### Hanover Hill paths:

### **Greenough Bridge:**

The old bridge across Greenough Pond was removed and the new bridge was built on the weekend of April 11. We had 21 volunteers. Lesson learned: when working in standing water, install bumpers before the volunteers arrive. George and Kevin later brought in road pack for the ends of the bridge. Steve will add the costs to our boardwalk summary spreadsheet.

#### **Trail Work This Month:**
