**Old Business:**

**Minutes from November 5 meeting:**

**Spencer Brook Boardwalk and Observation Platform:**

Solid Earth Technologies is planning on installing the helical anchors on or about December 9.

We need to let ConsCom know when the materials will be driven in to the site. This needs to be done after the ground freezes and before it snows, which may grant us a short window.
